AACT Stroud Jordan award to Michelle Frame

Michelle Frame has been selected as the 2022 recipient of the Stroud Jordan award by the American Association of Candy Technologists (AACT). The award will be presented at a banquet on October 18, 2022 during the National Technical Seminar.

Frame is president and founder of Victus Ars, a boutique food development lab focused on confectionery and related products. She has over 30 years' experience in the sweet snacking, supplement and OTC chewable categories, including a variety of technical roles at CPG and ingredient companies such as Mars, Just Born, Colony Brands, Mantrose, Fona, CSM and Kerry Ingredients.

Throughout her career, she has recognized the importance of industry organizations for networking, education and giving back to future generations. She has been a lead instructor for PMCA's panning course and University of Wisconsin – Madison's Candy School, led demonstrations and presented at

both PMCA and AACT.

She served as 2nd vice president, 1st vice president and president of AACT and continues to volunteer as facilities chair for the organization's National Technical Seminar.

In addition to AACT and PMCA, Frame is an active member of the National Confectioners Association, Western Candy Association, Institute of Food Technologists and Chicagoland Food and Beverage Network.

Frame is known for being an excellent mentor to those entering the confectionery industry and especially encouraging women in confectionery and science roles.

This award is given in honor of the late Stroud Jordan, a pioneer candy technologist, to recognize individuals who have provided exceptional and outstanding service, not just to the AACT, but to the confectionery industry as a whole.
